Compound uppers - Topographical limits to the non-tested components

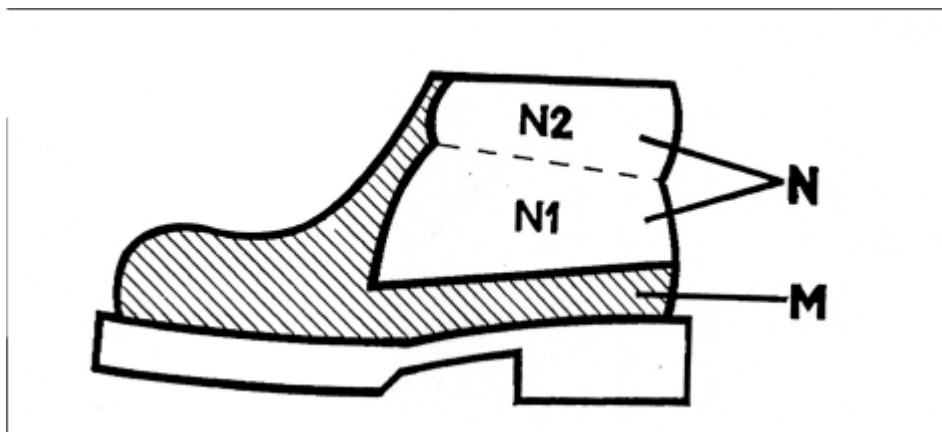
Question:

Let's consider the boot represented in the attached figure (design B). In this boot the shaft area and part of the quarters are made of material N, which in zone N2 is cushioned forming a collar.
In this case, should material N fulfil upper requirement?

Solution:

According to EN 344, 345,346 and 347, a normal collar (corresponding only to zone N2) is not tested

When the collar cover a larger area of the upper as in figure hereunder, material N forms part of the upper and should comply accordingly. It cannot be considered as a collar because it exceeds the cushioned area, and even if all material N were cushioned objections should also be made as, a collar, not subject to control, must be a minority part of the whole upper.
