Question: 1 A customer has a occupational shoe of polymeric , design A, seat region open and with perforation in the front. He would like to have the shoe certified according EN 347-1.this is not possible for me. 2 My customer says, that there is a manufacturer in Italy who has got the certificate according EN 347-1 for the same type of shoe (the name is calzuro; you can find the article under www. calzuro.it). My customer ask now, why the italian manufacturer could get a certificate, although the article doesn't correspond to the EN 347-1. What can we do against this; which institution checks such things? Shouldn't it be so, that all institutes test the same way ?			
Solution: 1 a occupational shoe of polymeric , design A, seat region open and with perforation in the front can not be certified according EN 347-1. 2 The application of the recommendations for use should be obligatory for all the notified bodies. The attendance to the meeting of VG is strongly recommended. If notified bodies don't respect the objective of the directive, the control of the market should help to detect them and their national authorities shall convince them to apply the VG decisions.
