Question: Testing of contact heat acc. ISO 17250 clause 7.1. "The sand around the shoe is taken to the right height." ISO 20344 cl. 5.12. What is the right height?			
Solution: The dimension of the sand bath and the volume of sand are fixed. Therefore, as soon as the footwear has been installed on the sand bath according to the standard, the right height of the sand is automatically fixed. The right height is the one given by the quantity of sand, the surface of the heating surface and the volume of the footwear.
