Question: According to the experience in laboratory (see CEN/TC161/WG1+2/WG2 N 557) leather fulfils the requirements of Annex B after testing flame resistance and radiant heat, but we have not found a single outsole or reflective material complying with it. We have tested seven reflective materials from a major world company. All fulfilled the requirements of 6.3.3, but none would pass Annex B.			
Solution: Assessment against Annex B is considered to be in contradiction to other requirements in the standard – for instance if a 2 second after flame time is permitted how can the sample not show signs of burning - It was therefore agreed to ignore assessment against Annex B for both the flammability and radiant heat tests.
