Question:

According to EN 15090, Table 9, the symbols F2 and F3 include all basic requirements in Table 4 for types 2 and 3. That means that the marking symbols in Table 4 can only be used when the property claimed is not mandatory, as it happens with, for example, with P and T. They are mandatory for Types 2 and 3, but not for Type 1.

Solution:

To avoid confusion in the market - To mark only what is relevant and not to duplicate reference to the same properties. If the symbol is F2A, it is not possible to mark P or T, because penetration and impact resistance are included in F2A. But it would be possible to mark F1 P A T.
