Point 6.4.3 Cleat height "When tested in accordance with the method described in 6.4.3 the cleated height d2 shall be not less than 2.5 mm. For multilayered outsoles the cleat height d2 shall be not less than 2.5 mm and for all-rubber and all-polymeric footwear the cleated height d2 shall be not less than 4 mm" When an outsole has 1 big cleated (>4mm height) in some areas and small cleats (< 2.5mm height) in others, how should be consider: - uncleated outsole or - cleated outsole?

If when measured in the cleated area (EN ISO 20345: 2004 Clause 6.4.1 / Figure 6) the cleats have the required depth (ie				
either > 2.5 mm or > 4 mm) then the outsole shall be considered as cleated, see below drawing
