Key words: Revision of standard, validity, EU type examination certificate			
Question: When a new version of an EN standard is published, are manufacturers obliged to get their products tested to the new/revised version or can they continue to sell their product(s)?			
Solution: Current certificates remain valid. However, manufacturers have a responsibility to keep abreast of changes and to modify their products in the light of these changes to continue to supply safe products, which may necessitate the issue of a new certificate.
