Revision EU type-examination

Question:  
In which cases is the expiry date of a certificate maintained and in which cases would a new 5 year validity apply in the case of an EU type-examination that requires a revision because of a change in the harmonised standard which affects the ESHRs. Will this modify its expiry date?

Solution:  
Depending on whether there is an effect on the product, the expiry date will be extended up to five years after the up-date.  
If the change to the harmonised standard affects the ESHRs / safety / a fundamental test of the standard, a new date will apply.  
In all other cases the original expiry date will be maintained.
